Santa Ana Castle has become an icon of the city. It all began in the early 16th century. At the initiative of Almería, a tower was built to guard the salt production at the Salinas salt mines. It is one of the main tourist attractions in Roquetas de Mar. It was declared an Area of National Tourist Interest, and it was decided to completely restore the fortress. Today, it is not only an important point of cultural interest but has also become the Roquetas de Mar Lighthouse Museum, a very interesting building to see in Roquetas de Mar.

Inaugurated in December 1863, **the lighthouse** is one of the best places to visit in Roquetas de Mar. Located just a few meters from Santa Ana Castle, it features a 9.5-meter-high tower. It is one of the best-preserved historical buildings. The lighthouse ceased to operate in May 1945 when a beacon light located on the harbor breakwater was put into operation.





A municipality that encompasses a coastal strip in the southwest of the province, including, among others, the towns of Aguadulce, El Parador, Las Marinas, Urbanización, and Las Salinas. Its boundaries include part of an area of great ecological interest, the Punta Entinas-Sabinar Nature Reserve, a complex of dunes, beaches, and lagoons of great ecological interest.

Much of its land is dedicated to intensive greenhouse agriculture, but its most important activity is sun and beach tourism. It has become the most important tourist area in the province, with first-class resorts such as Aquadulce, the Urbanización, and Roquetas itself, thanks to its well-maintained, clean beaches and adequate services and facilities.
